The County of Santa Clara Health System – comprising Santa Clara Valley Medical Center Hospital & Clinics, O'Connor Hospital, St Louise Regional Hospital, Santa County County Public Health Department and other affiliated agencies – is the largest provider of essential health services to vulnerable populations in our region.

STEMbassadors has redirected all resources to producing face shields for our hospital workers. With the help of the teachers we've trained, the continued use of equipment we've given away and machines donated by generous sponsors, we have been able to take action in a time of emergency. We are continually running 23 3D printers and diligently working to produce as many face shields as possible. Los Robles Regional Medical Center is a 382-bed acute care hospital dedicated to serving the residents of Ventura and Los Angeles Counties and the Greater Conejo Valley and its surrounding communities.

As the only Level II Trauma Center in East Ventura County, Los Robles Regional Medical Center is known for providing excellent medical care with compassion and kindness to each of their patients.

Families without housing are particularly at-risk during the COVID-19 outbreak. Families Forward continues to provide housing and supportive services for this vulnerable population without interruption through online, teleconference and over-the-phone service. Additionally, we have set up drive-thru food assistance, with proper distancing and sanitization protocol.

Ottawa Food Bank (OTT)

The Ottawa Food Bank provides fresh and non-perishable food, as well as supplies such as diapers, toiletries, and cleaning supplies to its network of over 100 emergency food programs across the city.

Fundacion Abriendo Carazones (ARG)

This was founded by a group of doctors from one big public hospital in Cordoba (Hospital Misericordia) They are usually focused on Neonatology and Maternity.

Because of the COVID'19 pandemic, they have offered all their resources to the Hospital Misericordia, in order to help the Hospital to organize a specific center for COVID-19 and to prevent the expansion of the disease. They are a good organization to help because through them we could provide the Hospital with disposable articles such as masks, gloves, etc. or depending on the amount of the donation, maybe some equipment. Public hospitals in Argentina need a lot of help.



San Mateo Hospital Foundation – Pavia (ITL)

The IRCCS Policlinico San Matteo Foundation has been at the forefront of the emergency management of Coronavirus for weeks, both for the analysis of swabs and for the care and assistance to all patients. Additionally, family members of some of our employees work at this hospital on the front lines helping patients.

With Pavia and Belgioioso offices, it is characterized by the high-quality hospitalization and care services and by its strong vocation for the integration of scientific research, assistance and teaching both in the Diagnosis and care facilities and in the Laboratories. The areas of excellence are many. Among these: cardiology, cardiac surgery, hematology, infectious diseases, orthopedics, pediatric oncohematology, robotic surgery, umbilical cord bank and the study of rare diseases .

#YoMeCorono (BCN)

A team of doctors and researchers from the Fight Against AIDS Foundation, IrsiCaixa and the Germans Trias i Pujol University Hospital is working tirelessly to come up with a response to the coronavirus as soon as possible.

Last week, the team started a pioneering clinical trial, the first approved by the Spanish Agency of Medicine, with the aim of defining which drugs will be used to immediately treat the infected and to prevent the infection of their contacts. Through another project, we are also working on a vaccine for the virus.

On the one hand, Dr. Bonaventura Clotet and Dr. Oriol Mitjà are leading a clinical trial that aims to stop the transmission of the virus. On the other hand, doctors Bonaventura Clotet, Roger Paredes, Julià Blanco, Jorge Carrillo and Nuria Izquierdo are working on a joint project with the Barcelona Supercomputing Center (BSC), the IRTA-CReSA and Grifols, which aims to develop drugs, antibodies and a vaccine for the new coronavirus and other similar future threats.



Daruieste Viata “the Happiness Exchange” (ROM)

An online fundraising platform for healthcare projects: sterile rooms, laboratories, oncology clinics, operating rooms, intensive care units, stem cell transplant units, or radiotherapy clinics. All investments are allotted in an efficient, transparent way, so that every investor can see where his money went, at all times.

Currently, donations go to infectious disease hospitals and emergency hospitals in the country, at the medical personnel who will be most exposed to the virus and who require the renewal of the protective equipment at every interaction with the patient, and consist in :

- Protective equipment for first-line medical personnel: suits, sterile gloves, masks, goggles, disinfectants, etc.
- Ventilation devices: most serious cases require mechanical ventilation
- Intubation probes
- Oxygen masks
- ECMO kits



Vietnam Fatherland Front Committee of HCMC

This is the official highest organization to get support COVID-19 for HCMC. The Standing Committee of the Vietnam Fatherland Front Committee of HCMC in coordination with the HCMC Health Department will promptly distribute to the organizations and individuals that are directly involved in epidemic prevention and treatment, areas that are in isolation, cases being treated for disease and individuals affected by the COVID-19 epidemic.
